RE: New Security Access System & Lobby Renovation

In order to enhance the security of its facility, CBOE is installing a new biometric security system. This new security system will control access to CBOE's building by comparing a person's actual fingerprint against the same fingerprint information stored on a chip embedded within an access badge. Everyone with access to CBOE's building, including CBOE employees, CBOE members and member personnel, and personnel of CBOE vendors, consultants and service providers, will have their fingerprints taken via the digital system installed in 2002 and will be issued a new access badge.

In conjunction with the installation of the new security access system, the CBOE lobby will be remodeled. Construction will begin on October 28, 2005 and is expected to continue through early January. A construction schedule and drawings will be exhibited in the lobby.

Once construction is complete and the building access system is implemented, the new access badges will be distributed. Details on badge distribution are forthcoming.
