## CBOE Hosts “Smart Money, Smart Women, Smart Options” Event

- The SEC recently approved a CBOE rule filing, which among other things, reorganized, simplified and made consistent various provisions of CBOE rules pertaining to Lead Market Makers, Supplemental Market Makers and Designated Primary Market Makers. - In June, certain Trading Permit Holders (TPHs) will be required to participate in a screen-based trading test, which is designed to simulate a scenario where CBOE converts to all-electronic screen-based trading in all products, both proprietary and multi-listed.
