

## **Regulatory Circular RG02-75**

RE: Restrictions on Transactions in

Sun Microsystems Inc. (SUNW/SUQ)

Trading in specific series in Sun Microsystems Inc. (SUNW/SUQ) has been restricted. The SUQ Nov 2½ and 5 options series have been restricted to closing customer orders only.

Only closing transactions may be effected in the SUQ Nov 2½ and 5 options series, except for (i) opening transactions by market-makers executed to accommodate closing transactions of other market participants and (ii) opening transactions by CBOE member organizations to facilitate the closing transactions of public customers executed as crosses pursuant to and in accordance with CBOE Rule 6.74(b or d). The SUQ Nov 2½ and 5 options series will not be traded on RAES.

The execution of opening transactions in the SUQ Nov 2½ and 5 options series, except as permitted above, and/or the misrepresentation as to whether an order is opening or closing, will constitute a violation of CBOE rules, and may result in disciplinary action.

There are no restrictions in place with respect to the exercise of UOR options and the Options Clearing Corporation (OCC) has advised CBOE that the expiration of UOR options will remain subject to OCC's Exercise-by-Exception Procedures.
