

Regulatory Circular RG14-176

RE: Floor Broker Workstation 2

Beginning January 2, 2015, a new version of the Floor Broker Workstation, called FBW2, is expected to be made available to Trading Permit Holder ("TPH") broker groups on the trading floor of the CBOE. Among its many features, and in preparation for the regulatory requirement announced in Regulatory Circular RG14-153 that requires complex orders of 12 and fewer legs to be entered on a single order ticket, the new application will provide a multi-leg ticket that may include up to twelve (12) legs. Users of the current FBW version should be aware that support for that version will be discontinued six months after availability of FBW2. Accordingly, users are encouraged to review FBW2 functionality as soon as possible.

Floor Broker TPHs are being contacted to arrange a detailed training session for their FBW user group. Users are also encouraged to go to Post 10 for a hands-on practice session on FBW2.

Training materials will be supplied in advance of the FBW2 rollout.
