

Choe Europe Introduces Weekend Testing Webpage

OVERVIEW

Applicable Choe Exchanges: Choe Europe Equities ("BXE," "CXE," "DXE," "TRF", "SIS") and Choe Europe Derivatives ("CEDX").

Effective Saturday, 1st March 2025, Cboe Europe (Cboe) will introduce Production BXE, CXE, DXE, TRF, SIS (Equities) and CEDX (Derivatives) environments for weekend testing.

Updates will be available on the <u>Europe Weekend Testing Availability Webpage</u>, showing all available customer testing weekends for a rolling 90-day period for the supported exchanges/trading platforms.

TECHNICAL DETAILS

Cboe is introducing a new weekend testing webpage in the European region detailing the production customer testing availability for the upcoming 90-day period for each of the supported exchanges/trading platforms. For each exchange/trading platform, weekends will be color-coded to signify testing status, as follows:

- Green: Production customer weekend testing is available with Trade Desk support.
- Yellow: Production customer weekend testing is available without Trade Desk support.
- Red: Production customer weekend testing is unavailable.

Participants should take the following actions:

Production Data – Please ensure that your production systems are not configured to send
production trade reports when Cboe systems come up on Saturday mornings, as <u>all data from</u>
these weekend test days will be discarded as test data.
